


## Palm Beach County Gross Domestic Product




#### Current Population Palm Beach County









## Looking ahead

1) Palm Beach County economy outpaces national growth. We expect county GDP to continue to grow with our strong economic foundation.

2) Housing Market Stabilization – Active listings are rising, and home prices are calming. However, affordability remains a challenge.

3) Job Growth – Employment growth remains above and unemployment rates remain below national average, putting upward pressure on wages.

4) Population Growth & Income Migration – Florida is forecasted to remain #1 in the country for net income migration, attracting high-net-worth individuals. However, we must retain young talent to maintain future competitiveness.
